



With Adobe Illustrator tools you can create many forms of shapes and can be basic or complex. The default shape tool is the Rectangle Tool. To draw a square using the Rectangle Tool or a perfect circle using the Ellipse Tool.



## **5.1DRAWINGBASIC SHAPES**


The Polygon & Star Tools work in much the same way as the Ellipse and Rectangle tools do to allow you to easily create complex vector shapes.

### **5.2 DRAWING POLYGONS & STARS**

In Illustrator, there are line objects and shape objects. Lines are made of points, and shapes are made of boundaries. Since line objects are not easily resized or manipulated, you will want to convert your line into a shape. Object -> Path -> Outline Stroke.
